

Introduction

The course is suitable for students who already know how to play chess at least at intermediate level (i.e know some tactics and the rules of proper development). There will be lessons on some theory but the main emphasize is for the students to play at the time control used in the National Schools Individual Championships (NSI). The students will learn to manage their time better and be more confident while participating in the NSI. At the end of each session, common mistakes will be addressed and general comments will be given. If a student requires a more thorough analyse of the student's games, the student will have to arrange for private lesson(s) with a trainer, at a different time.

This course **is ideal** for students who do not have a chess club in school and are participating in the NSI.

Students do not have to attend all sessions but discount will be given to those who register and pay for the sessions by 15 Feb 2017 (*please see charges below*).
